How did Ent Credit Union get its name?

Many organizations are named after notable people or where they were started. Ent Credit Union's name reflects both.

Your credit union was founded on the former Ent Air Force Base in Colorado Springs. Base leaders wanted to encourage their predominantly young military and civilian staff to make smart use of their money. Their solution? Start a nonprofit credit union right on base.

As for the base, it was named for a true hero: Air Force Maj. Gen. Uzal Girard Ent. During World War II, Maj. Gen. Ent won distinction, in part, for launching destructive aerial blows against Axis targets.

Today, we're proud to continue honoring our name's legacy by putting those we serve first.

Check the name

If you get an email or text from ENT (all capital letters) or Ent Federal, it's a scam. Our correct name is Ent Credit Union.

What info we'll never ask you for

You can also spot a scammer by what they ask for. We won't call, text, or email you for the information below. In fact, it's likely we already have it on file.



- Credit or debit card PIN
- Digital banking username or password
- Account number and routing number
- CVV2 code on the back of your credit or debit card
- FULL Social Security number
- Verification code
