



## Your Vehicle Loan Is Pre-Approved! Here Are Your Next Steps.

Any correspondence containing sensitive and/or personal information can be emailed securely by utilizing Ent's secure mail option. Your assigned Lending Specialist will provide you with their direct email address for delivery of supporting loan documentation and information regarding our secure mail option. You can also choose to fax documentation to Ent's Lending Center at (719) 550-7199. Please reference your loan application number on your documents.

### Dealer Purchase:

- You can ask for Ent financing at the dealership to ensure a quick and convenient car buying experience. Please contact your assigned Lending Specialist for information regarding participating dealerships. For non-participating dealerships, please ask to have a signed purchase order, along with a copy of the front and back of the motor vehicle title faxed or emailed to Ent.

### Private Party Purchase:

- **Private party purchase, vehicle is financed.** Seller will need to email or fax Ent an image of their registration card along with: odometer reading, agreed upon selling price, seller contact number, and seller's physical home address. Next, the seller will need to contact the financial institution where their vehicle is financed, and request that their lender fax or email Ent an official 10 day loan payoff statement, including daily interest.
- **Private party purchase, vehicle is owned free and clear.** Seller will need to email or fax Ent an image of the front and back of the motor vehicle title along with: odometer reading, agreed upon selling price, seller contact number, and seller's physical/home address.

### Refinancing:

- Please email or fax Ent an image of your vehicle's registration card. Please contact the financial institution that your automobile is currently financed with and request that they fax or email Ent an official 10 day loan payoff statement, to include daily interest.

### Free and Clear Title As Collateral:

- Please email or fax Ent an image of the front and back of your motor vehicle title.

Once Ent receives the requested supporting documentation, you will be contacted by a Lending Specialist to finalize your loan application.
